Focusing on earthquakes, fires and floods this course helps people prepare for before, during & after the emergency. The course covers the five key steps including: 1) how to survive in your home for 5 to 7 days 2) storing & maintaining your supplies 3) how & when to shut-off utilities 4) preparing & storing vital documents 5) family planning for evacuation, communication and more. C.E.R.T. (Community Emergency Response Team)

C.E.R.T., is a national Citizens Corp. volunteer program sponsored by FEMA. The training helps everyone to be better prepared to respond to and cope with disasters and emergencies at home, in your neighborhood, at work and throughout your community. After completing the course, C.E.R.T.s will be able to provide immediate assistance to handle small fires, turn off utilities, give first aid, perform light search & rescue, organize walk-up volunteers, and collect information which arriving professional first responders need to prioritize & allocate resources. Certification Courses & ARC Lifeguard Training Certification Course (LGT)

Course Description: This course will provide participants training in entry-level lifeguard skills and knowledge to prevent, recognize and respond to, and provide aid in aquatic and land emergency situations. The American Red Cross Lifeguard Training is the course you need to become a certified lifeguard. Upon successful completion of all portions of the course, participants will be issued certificates in Lifeguard Training/First Aid, and CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer (valid for 2 years). Please bring swimsuit and towel to class every day. Participants must attend every day of class. No make-ups or rescheduling will be offered.

Prerequisites: Participants must be 15 years of age by last day of the course. On the first day of class, participants must complete a pre-course fitness test involving a 300 yard swim, treading water, and a time brick swim. Participants must also complete an 8-10 hour online program through the America Red Cross website. Additional information regarding prerequisites and course requirements can be found on our website. Upon successful registration, participants will be sent an email with instructions on how to register for online portion of class.

ARC Lifeguard Instructor Course (LGI)

Become an American Red Cross (ARC) Lifeguard Instructor. Learn how to teach classes including basic-level lifeguarding, shallow water attendant, Lifeguard Management, CPR/AED, Administering Emergency Oxygen, Blood borne Pathogens Training and Basic Water Rescue. Course also includes ARC Fundamentals of Instructor Training Course.

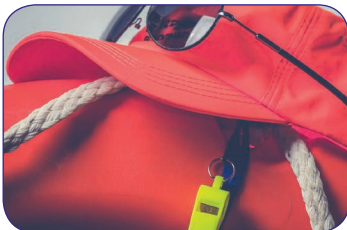

CPR/AED, First-Aid for the Professional Rescuer-Blended Learning

Course Description This course will teach participants the knowledge and skills in how to recognize and respond to emergencies, and assess and provide care to individuals in need. Participants will learn how to respond to breathing & cardiac emergencies, physical injuries, and sudden illnesses. This course is not a lifeguard certification course. This course utilizes the American Red Cross Blended Learning program. Participants will be required to complete an online program prior to the first day of class. A copy of the online completion certification must be submitted to the instructor on the first day of class.
