2010-2011 Tennis Court Rules & Regulations

MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

1. COURTS RESERVED EXCLUSIVELY FOR "KEY HOLDERS" of Strawberry Recreation District. COURT USE HOURS ARE RESTRICTED FROM 7:00 AM TO 10:00 PM ONLY.
2. Pass holders must possess a Strawberry Recreation issued picture identification card. Key holders without a Strawberry Recreation issued picture identification card are not permitted on the courts. Identification may be challenged at anytime by other players or managers.
3. Residents of Strawberry Recreation District may purchase keys annually at \$100.00 each. Proof of residency required. Keys are valid from 4/01/10 to 3/31/11.
4. Non-residents of the Strawberry area may purchase keys annually at \$140.00 each.
5. Additional household members of key holder who use the courts must be added to the membership at \$40.00 additional per extra family member and be issued a Strawberry Recreation picture identification card. Family / household members may not play free or use the "guest fee" rate.
6. Additional household members with Strawberry Recreation identification cards may purchase a second key for \$25.00.
7. Juniors (under 18 years) may purchase keys annually at \$60.00 each. NO residency required. In combination adult-child memberships, adult must be primary key holder.

POLICIES

8. RESERVATIONS- (One and half hour limit)
Monday - Friday from 8:00 am to 9:00am and from 12 noon to 9:00 pm on Court #2
Saturdays/Holidays from 8:00am to 9:00 am and from 12 noon to 9:00pm on Court #4
No reservations allowed from 9:00 am to 12 noon on Weekdays/Saturdays/Holidays when all courts are available on a "first come/first served" basis.
Sunday reservations can be made for 8:00am to 9:00pm on the Thursday before for Courts 3 & 4. No person may reserve more than one court per weekend/holidays. Only ONE reservation is held at a time. The reservation is forfeited if two persons who reserved the court are not present within 10 minutes after the start of the reservation period. Next persons waiting for a court shall be entitled to play on said court. A list of those reserving courts shall be posted at the tennis courts each day. The courts may be reserved for either singles or doubles play. Names of all players must be indicated. Minimum 2 players.

RESERVATION PROCEDURES

Call the District office weekdays from 9:00am to 2:00pm at 383-6494.

Weekdays: one day in advance notice.

Weekends: reservation accepted Thursday and Friday only.

9. Guests must be accompanied by key holder at all times. No guests allowed
Weekdays/Saturday/Holidays from 9:00am to 12noon. Key holder use only. Guests allowed on reservation court #4 only.

Guest fees are \$3.00 per guest per play. Fees are due in the Recreation Office PRIOR to use of the courts. Use the drop-box slot by the recreation office after hours—(please identify member name & guest name).
Any member who fails to pay for his guests prior to play or lends his/her tennis key to a non-member can face forfeiture of membership.
10. All courts are reserved for adults (18 or older) on Tuesday through Fridays after 6:00pm and on weekends and holidays until noon. This includes the reservation courts. Junior playing with an adult should be considered an adult.
11. Court availability may be restricted by Strawberry Recreation District for authorized tennis activities. Call office for schedule. Dates will also be posted at courtside.

FACILITY USE RULES

12. Gate must be locked at ALL times.
13. TENNIS SHOES allowed (not running shoes) only. No shoes with heels or black/rubber soles allowed. Appropriate complete tennis attire required at all times.
14. Courts are for tennis use only. No toddlers, strollers, animals, bicycles, roller skates, scooters or skateboards allowed.
15. Remove refuse - place in containers.
16. Proper tennis etiquette must be practiced at all times.

PLAYING RULES

- A. Pegboard system determines order of play. Each person places racquet in the first vacant position. When court is available those persons whose racquets are in the lowest numbered positions are next. Other waiting players shall move their racquets up the pegboard. No persons on court shall have a racquet on the pegboard.
 - B. Warm up - 10 minutes maximum before starting set.
 - C. Rally period - 45 minutes maximum, in lieu of playing a set.
 - D. ALL players must relinquish court after completing two sets.
18. Doubles play - the winning team may stay on the court for a second set.
 19. After second set of doubles is played, if the same team wins, all four players must leave the court to be replaced by two or more players waiting to play. Losers in the second set described in this rule have priority for placing racquets on pegboard.
 20. Persons wishing to play tennis have priority over a single person wishing to use the backboards.
 21. Only THREE balls are allowed on court at any one time unless adjacent court is not in use. Authorized Strawberry Recreation District lessons or Strawberry Recreation District ball machine renters accepted.
 22. No SINGLES play can be started when people are waiting. Doubles play only.
