

## **Strawberry Recreation District (SRD) Aquatics Facility Guidelines**

- A. It is expected that you do not come to the pool if you are experiencing any symptoms of cold, flu or Covid, and/or if you've had active diarrhea in the past 24 hours.
- B. Parents must be in the pool no further than arm's length with children 6 years and younger, and older children who are not water safe.
- C. Children under the age of three and those who are not reliably potty trained must wear swim diapers. Swim diapers are available for purchase in the SRD Lifeguard Office.
- D. No innertubes, rafts, blow-up floaties, or water wings permitted in the pool. Lifejackets must be Coast Guard approved. SRD has life jackets for children 2 – 5 years old. Please ask a lifeguard.
- E. Use of a lifejacket is not a substitute for required parental supervision of children 6 years and under and older children who are not water safe.
- F. Walk, don't run around the pool.
- G. No climbing on structures, walls, and furniture around the pool.
- H. Diving permitted off the diving board only – when safe to do so.
- I. Only one person permitted on the diving board at a time.
- J. No cartwheels, handstands or hanging off the diving board.
- K. No hanging on lane lines and dividers.
- L. Everyone must listen to instructions by lifeguards and obey all pool rules.
- M. 16 years and over in the spa. This rule is strictly enforced.
- N. No roughhousing in or around the pool.
- O. No dunking, excessive breath holding, jumping on top of another person, non-emergency screaming, or inappropriate physical behavior permitted.
- P. No glass permitted at the pool.
- Q. Children under 16 using the Aquatic's facility must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- R. No changing on the pool deck.
- S. No nudity – family appropriate attire and swimwear are required.
- T. No smoking, vaping use of any kind permitted on SRD premises.
- U. Chairs and umbrellas may not be moved.
- V. No pets permitted on SRD property.

### **Emergency Action Plan**

In the event of an emergency, patrons are required to follow staff and lifeguard's instructions completely. All patrons must clear the pool in the event of a rescue and an incident report must be completed with the injured party and supervisor following the incident. Please understand that our lifeguards are acting to ensure the safety of all patrons.

SRD staff holds the final say. Any argumentative or unsafe action will not be tolerated and could result in the loss of swimming/event/membership privileges. Our goal is to provide a safe and enjoyable environment for all patrons, and we appreciate your respect of our measures.

Management reserves the right to change or alter any rules and/or policies as needed. All rules and regulations are in place to ensure the safety of every patron and our team appreciates your cooperation.
