

# Pool Membership Agreement – Updated 2026

## 2026 Pool Membership Agreement

### Pool Membership Cancellation Policy

- Pool Memberships are non-transferable
- Pool Memberships are refundable up to 3 days prior to the start date of the pool membership with a \$25 cancellation fee
- No Refunds will be given once the membership has started

### Annual Pool Membership Policies and Guidelines

- Annual Pool Memberships are discounted 10% compared to purchasing all four seasonal memberships
- Annual Pool Memberships are sold until January 31
- Family members cannot be added at a pro-rated rate
- Annual pool members are subject to follow the seasonal pool hours and schedules

Please view the Aquatics page on SRD website for current pool schedule. Pool schedule changes seasonally based on facility usage, staffing and program needs.

## Membership Details

1. Each household is limited to making **2 initial reservations per week**, each Tuesday between 12:15p - 12:30p. Members may only use primary passholders name (account) to make all reservations. If couples would like to swim together, they must come together under 1 reservation or come during drop in hours.
2. SRD pool passes are non-refundable\* and non-transferable. \*Pool passes are refundable up to 3 days prior to the start date of the pass, less a \$25 cancellation fee. No refunds will be given once the pool membership period has started. Members may not be added to an annual pass after January 31, 2024.
3. To use the pool, all members included on each SRD pool pass must be immediate family and live in the same household. Household members must be included on a pass to use the pool.
4. Proof of residency and age are required for resident and senior discounts.

5. **Swim instruction is prohibited by anyone outside of your immediate family.**
6. Daycare providers may be added to the household pass with proof of employment and/or proof of live-in care.
  1. Daycare providers may only use the pool while children and or family on pool pass are present. This pass is not for individual use.
  2. If a daycare provider is not on the pool membership, they must be over the age of 18 and signed in/paid for as a guest each time they visit the pool with children.
7. Failure to follow SRD rules and regulations may result in the suspension of your pool pass. Repeated failure to follow SRD regulations may result in revocation of your pool pass. If questions arise about SRD rules, patrons need to request clarification from SRD staff. Only SRD staff are permitted to enforce SRD rules and regulations.
8. Showering is limited to rinsing off - please do not use shampoo or body soap to reduce water use
9. SRD reserves the right to change the reservation schedule and lane allocation, based swim lessons, summer camp, usage patterns and lap swim lane sharing.
10. Lanes 2, 3 & 4 will be booked as shared lanes. You may enter on any side of the lane you wish. Please workout with your lane partner which side you will both be swimming on. We will not have chairs behind the deep end anymore. When booking a shared lane, it is possible patrons will have to share with two patrons from a different household. Please keep this in mind when booking your reservation.
11. The teaching pool will be divided and shared with lessons and or other patrons.
12. Lap swim is for 16 yrs. and up, only.
  1. 13 - 15 years old must be accompanied by an adult and take the lap swim test. Lap swim test is 2 laps showing they can circle swim or splitting the lane. This is not for receiving a swim lesson, this is for the purpose of lap swimming.
13. **LANE/SECTION SWITCHING MUST BE AUTHORIZED BY SRD STAFF. MEMBERS MAY NOT, ON THEIR OWN, SWITCH TO ANOTHER LANE OR REC AREA.**
14. Lap lane reservations are not required 2-5pm. Members only may drop in and swim.
15. Children 3 years and under, or those who are not potty trained, are required to wear a swim diaper in the pool at all times.

16. If your child has a fecal accident in the pool, you are required to tell SRD staff
17. Those who fail to follow these rules or inform SRD staff of a fecal accident at the aquatics facility will be issued a \$250 fine.
18. Pool members must respect reservation times by not entering early and exiting on time.
19. Pool members MUST inform their lane partner when entering the pool to avoid collisions.
20. If someone is in your reserved lane during your reservation time, please tell a lifeguard.

### **Additional Pool Rules**

1. No blow up floaties, water guns, water polo balls or hard balls allowed thrown in the pool
2. All life jackets must be coast guard approved
3. Children 15 and under must be accompanied by an adult pool member
4. 1 person at a time on the diving board
5. Diving board area must be clear before next person jumps
6. No kick boards in family rec area - kickboards and pull buoys are for lap swimming and swim lessons only
7. Children under 7 or not water safe must have an adult in the water at all times
8. Children wearing life jackets must have an adult in the water within arms reach
9. Parents/guardians are the primary adult responsible for their children's safety even when lifeguards on duty
10. No one is to enter the pool prior to opening
11. Everyone must exit the pool by 6:05pm Monday - Friday and 5:05pm Saturday and Sunday
12. Must be 12 years old or older and be able to proficiently lap swim to swim in lap lanes
13. No climbing on structures, walls, and furniture around the pool.

14. Diving permitted off the diving board only – when safe to do so. I. Only one person permitted on the diving board at a time.
15. No cartwheels, handstands or hanging off the diving board.
16. No hanging on lane lines and dividers.
17. Everyone must listen to instructions by lifeguards and obey all pool rules.
18. 16 years and over in the spa. This rule is strictly enforced.
19. No roughhousing in or around the pool.
20. No dunking, excessive breath holding, jumping on top of another person, non-emergency screaming, sitting on shoulder or inappropriate physical behavior permitted.
21. No glass permitted at the pool.
22. Children under 16 using the Aquatic's facility must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
23. No changing on the pool deck.
24. No nudity – family appropriate attire and swimwear are required.
25. No smoking, vaping use of any kind permitted on SRD premises.
26. Chairs and umbrellas may not be moved.
27. No pets permitted on SRD property.

### **Emergency Action Plan**

In the event of an emergency, patrons are required to follow staff and lifeguard's instructions completely. All patrons must clear the pool in the event of a rescue and an incident report must be completed with the injured party and supervisor following the incident. Please understand that our lifeguards are acting to ensure the safety of all patrons.

SRD staff holds the final say. Any argumentative or unsafe action will not be tolerated and could result in the loss of swimming/event/membership privileges. Our goal is to provide a safe and enjoyable environment for all patrons, and we appreciate your respect of our measures.

Management reserves the right to change or alter any rules and/or policies as needed. All rules and regulations are in place to ensure the safety of every patron and our team appreciates your cooperation.

SRD may enforce rules not listed for the safety of all patrons at the pool.

### **Reservations**

1. Each household is limited to making 2 initial reservations per week, each Tuesday.
  - Additional reservations may be made NO MORE than 1 day before a wanted reservation. No exceptions. All reservations made on Tuesday for Wednesdays are considered 1 of 2 of your initial reservations.
  - All additional reservations made over the 2 limit on Tuesdays and/or outside the day in advance window will be canceled without notice
2. Reservations are required from the time the facility open until 2pm everyday
3. Pool members may drop in 2pm-5pm everyday OR MWF 12pm-2pm for lap swim; members may drop in for family rec swim Mon-Fri 2pm-6pm and Sat/Sun 12pm-5pm.
4. Lap swimming is not permitted in open family swim/rec areas.
5. Each household is limited to 1 reservation per day, no exceptions.
5. Reservations are non-transferable outside of the household.
6. Only the primary member on each account can make reservations.
7. If more than 1 person on the household membership plans to lap swim, all reservations must be made under 1 member - this allows SRD to keep track of reservations under memberships
8. When making a reservation, input primary passholder's last name in 'description of use'.
9. Lap lane reservations are full lap swimming, water walking and treading only
10. Lap lanes may not be reserved to teach your child a lessons - outside instructors are not permitted to teach at SRD

### **Cancellations/Late/No-Show Rules and Fees Policy**

1. Cancellations must be made no less than 1 hour in advance to avoid fees:

- Reservations canceled with just 1 hour or less before the reservation start time will be charged a \$5.00 cancellation fee.
- No-shows will be charged a \$5.00 cancellation fee

2. To cancel reservations, please call the SRD office between 9:00am - 5:00pm, Monday - Friday. During off hours and weekends, please email; swim@strawberryrec.org or gm@strawberryrec.org.

3. Switching swim times to bypass cancellation fees is not permitted. SRD will cancel your reservation and fees will be assessed based on the cancellation policy. Members are permitted to rebook online once their reservation is cancelled. SRD staff will not switch your reservation time.

4. SRD will suspend outdoor activities when air quality exceeds 150 on the AQI scale (Purple Air average for Strawberry Peninsula and surrounding area). Reservations cancelled when AQI is under 150, will be charged as stated above.

### **Guest Policy**

1. 1 guest \$10, 2 guests, \$20, 3 guests \$25, 4 guests \$30

2. Maximum of 4 guests per membership, per day

3. Guests are allowed for Rec Swim. Guests are permitted for lap swimming in lanes 1 & 5 only with member reservation and member present.

4. Guests must stay with members at all times, may only swim in their member's reservation area, and leave when reservation is over.

5. Guests must be signed in and paid for prior to entering the pool, or in the area beyond the check-in table. Guest fees can be paid by credit card, check or exact change (cash).

6. Guests coming to observe must pay guest fees.

7. All guests entering the pool area must sign the SRD waiver prior to going beyond the check-in area.

**8. Bringing the maximum amount of guests to host a party including decorations is not permitted - pool parties are available to book through SRD office**

9. Household family members may not be guests, they must be added to the pool membership

10. MEMBERS MUST accompany guests at all times - once the member leaves the aquatic facility, guests must leave the aquatic facility.

11. Bringing guests and party decorations to avoid booking a pool party is not permitted. All pool parties must be booked and approved through SRD office to allow for proper staffing at the pool.

## **INDEMNIFICATION**

The participant shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Strawberry Recreation District (SRD), its officers, employees, and agents from any and all losses, costs, expenses, claims, liabilities, actions, or damages, including liability for injuries to any person or persons or damage to property arising at any time out of or in any way related to the users use or occupancy of a facility or property controlled by SRD, unless solely caused by the gross negligence or willful misconduct of SRD, its officers, employees, or agents.

In consideration for being permitted by SRD to participate in group exercise classes, I hereby waive release, and discharge any and all claims for damages for personal injury, death, or property damage which I may have, or which may hereafter accrue to me, as a result of participation in said activity. This release is intended to discharge in advance, SRD, its officers, employees, volunteers, and agents from any and all liability arising out of or connected in anyway with my participation in any activity at SRD, even through that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness, active or passive, on the part of the persons or entities, including Independent Contractors employed by SRD.

It is understood that this activity involves an element of risk and danger of accidents and knowing those risks I hereby assume those risks. It is further agreed that this waiver, release and assumption of risk is to be binding on my heirs, administrators, executors, and assigns. I agree to indemnify and hold SRD, its officers, employees, volunteers and agents, and its Independent Contractors free and harmless from any loss, liability, damage, cost, or expense which may arise out of or connected in anyway with my participation in said activity.

Additionally, I fully understand that my participation in the above-referenced activity exposes me to the risk of personal injury, death, communicable diseases, illnesses, viruses, and/or property damage. I hereby acknowledge that I am voluntarily participating in this activity and agree to assume any such risks.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS AGREEMENT, WAIVER AND RELEASE AND FULLY UNDERSTAND IT'S CONTENTS. I AM AWARE THAT THI IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND A CONTRACT BETWEEN MYSELF AND SRD, AND I SIGN IT OF MY FREE WILL.
